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MAP of Wisconsin, showing 1,500 Miles of proposed National Highways. These highways will directly serve 1,721,602 inhabitants of the counties through which they pass, which is 74% of the total population of the State. Abutting counties have a population of 533,176, which is 23% of the total State population—being a total of 2,254,778 inhabitants, equal to 97% served and abutting on these proposed National Highways. The total road mileage in the State is 61,090, so that 2.46% in National Highway mileage will serve directly or abutting 97% of the people.
