MAP of Alabama, showing 1,500 Miles of proposed National Highways. These highways will directly serve 1,543,335 inhabitants of the counties through which they pass, which is 72% of the total population of the State. Abutting counties have a population of 555,830, which is 26% of the total State population—being a total of 2,099,165 inhabitants, equal to 98% served and abutting on these proposed National Highways. The present total road mileage in the State is 49,639, so that 3.02% in National Highway mileage will serve directly or abutting 98% of the people.

Similar maps of other States are being prepared by the Association and will be issued as rapidly as possible.
