


MAP OF NORTHERN ARABIA

The figures give the approximate heights above the sea in English feet, accompanied with an actual barometer made and tested by Gauss, N.B. These figures may be best relied on as regards Central Arabia. The journey between Mehad Ali and Shuarah was made during violent changes of weather.
