By Advices received this morning from Bombay, intelligence has been received of the arrival at that Port of the ship Endeavour from Bufforah, which she left the 11th November 1804.

The Endeavour brings English News Papers down to the 24th August, and Foreign Papers to the 10th September 1804.

The Principal Heads of Intelligence transmitted from Bombay, are the following:—

The Russian Charge d'Affaires, left Paris in August, and a Rupture between the two Countries is expected to be the consequence. Hostilities are also expected to take place between France and Sweden.

Captain Dance, of the Honorable Company's service, Knighted for his gallant conduct in repulsing Admiral Linois. A donation of 50,000l. has been made by the Company, to the Captains, Officers, and Seamen of the China Fleet, opposed to Admiral Linois.

Lord Granville Leveson Gower is appointed Ambassador to Russia.

It is confidently reported, that an attempt has been made to poison His Majesty Louis XVIII, by Bonaparte's Agents. Louis the XVIII, has since retired to Willna, the Capital of Russian Lithuania.

Admiral Lord Viscount Duncan, is dead of the Gout.

Georges and eleven others have been beheaded. They died crying out *Vive Le Roi*: Bonaparte's Myrmidons calling out, at the same time, *Vive l'Empereur*.

Surinam taken, and General Green appointed Governor.

The Devaynes, for Madeira, Bombay, and Madras, and the Skelton Castle, for Madeira and Bombay, were to sail about the end of August.

The following Articles have been Extracted from the Franckfort Journal.

Lord Moira married to the Countess of Loudon.

The Emperor of Germany has assumed the Title of Hereditary Emperor of Austria, independent of his Germanic Title of Emperor of the Romans. This is, (His Imperial Majesty declares in a Proclamation of the 11th August 1804) for the purpose of keeping himself on an equality with France.

Venice declared a free Port.

The Pope has re-established the Jesuits in the Kingdom of Naples.

The King of Sweden at the Diet of Ratibon, has objected to the new Imperial Title assumed by Austria.

The Pope is to be present at the inauguration of Bonaparte.

The King of England and Royal Family arrived at Weymouth on the 28th of August.

Extract from the Ligurian Moniteur, under the head of Genoa, 25th August 1804.

Letters were yesterday received from Leghorn of the 22d Instant, which announce that, in consequence of orders issued by the French General, a sequestration had been ordered of all Russian and Swedish Vessels in that Port. This measure was at first considered as the precursor of a formal rupture with the Courts of Russia and Sweden. It is further added, that the Austrian Shipping were preparing to clear out from Leghorn. These fears have been removed by an Express arrived at Leghorn yesterday evening. It states that, immediately after the arrival of a Courier from Paris, the sequestration was countermanded.

The China Fleet, Leeward Island Fleet, and Lisbon Fleet, have all arrived in safety in England.

A part of the French Fleet at Brest, under Admiral Gantheaume, attempted to get out of Brest, but on the 3d August, were obliged to come to an anchor in Camarette Bay, about eight miles to the Southward of Brest. The ships with him are said to amount to nine Sail of the Line, and three Frigates. Admiral Graves in watching this Squadron.

Lieutenant Colonel Hoghton arrived in London, on the 14th August, from India.
