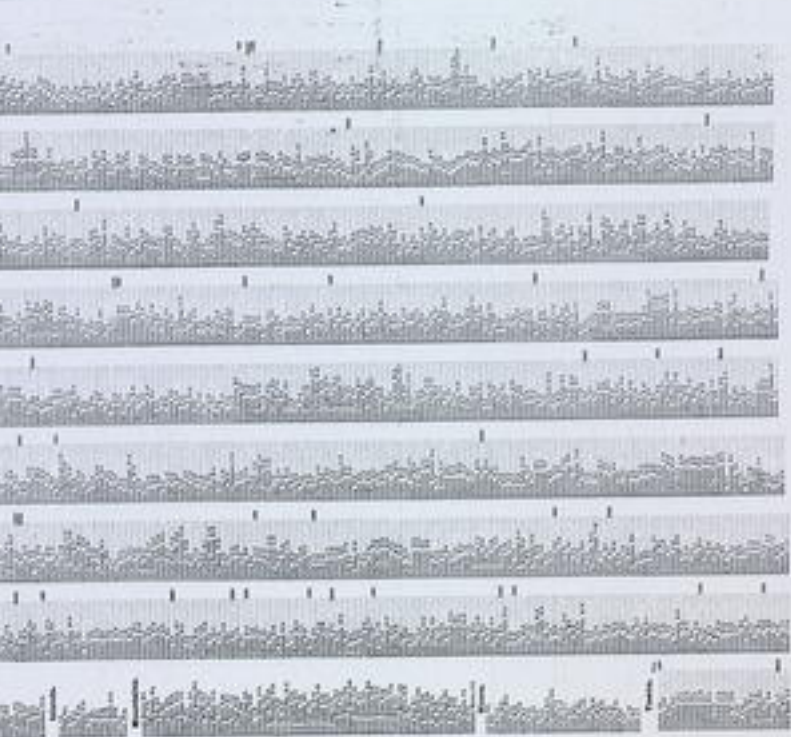


PERSIA, AFGHANISTAN, BALUCHISTAN.

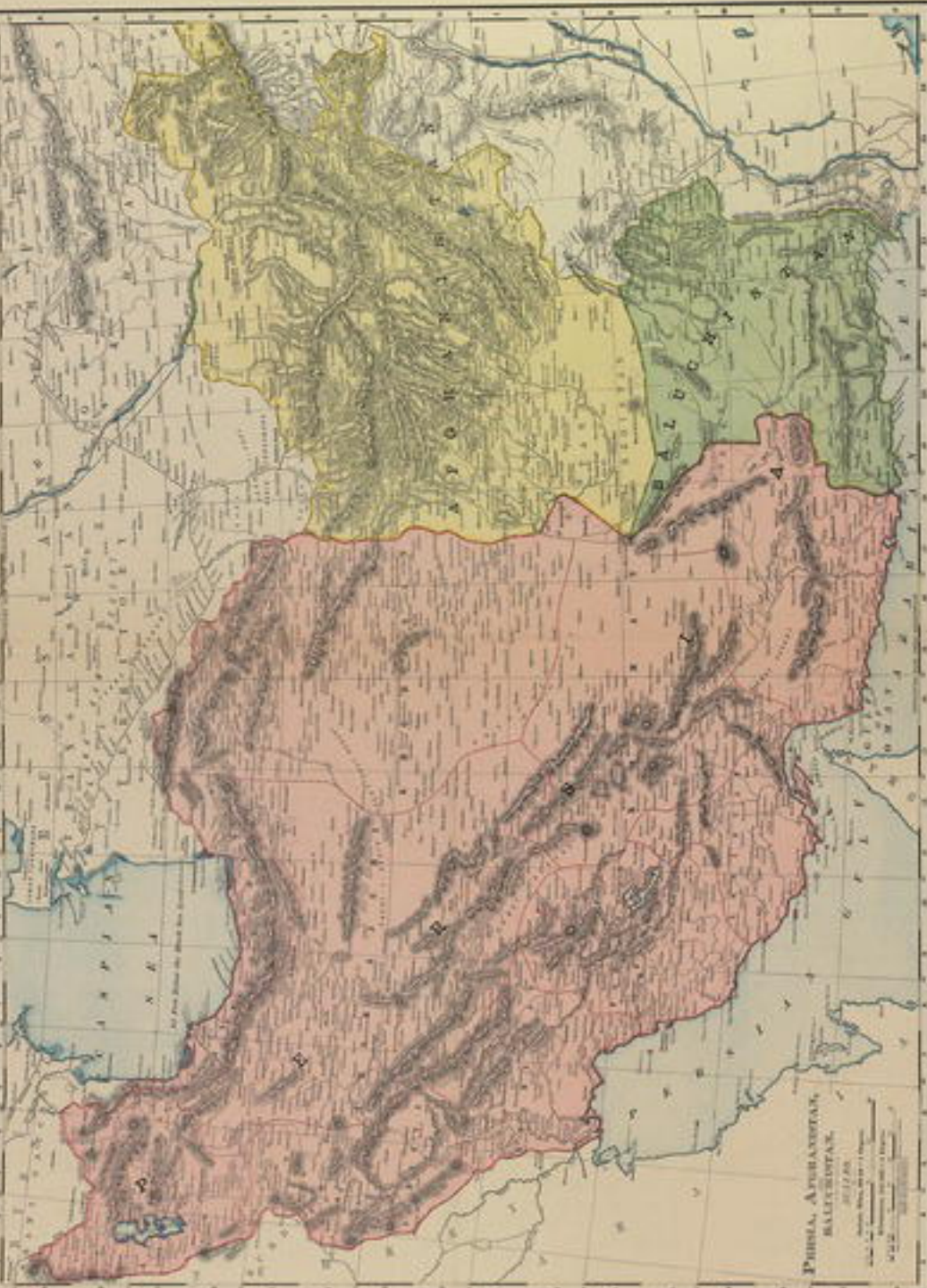
